Rules and General Information

- **Proper attire** is required in all classes; **PROTECTIVE A.S.T.M / S.E.I. APPROVED HEADGEAR IS MANDATORY AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED.** Chin straps must be snug.
- **Classes will be judged** on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. **Horses and ponies** may enter **no more than seven classes over fences per day, including equitation .**
- **Questions; not covered by GHJA rules;** will be decided by the horse show management; such decision shall be final.
- **Minor exhibitors;** - Parents or guardians shall hold the management, staff, and facility of the horse show harmless for any injury to such minor. A minor's entry will only be accepted when it is signed by a parent or guardian.
- **Golf Carts & Motorized Vehicles;** *may not be driven by Unlicensed Drivers* anywhere on the show grounds; violators are subject to suspension from the show . Refer to USEF GR 1301.7.
- **The courtesy circle** may be restricted by a mandatory dotted line which will be indicated on the course diagram. In classes with a posted order of go, the **1 minute rule** will be in effect. All other classes may invoke the **3 minute rule.**
- **Flat/Under Saddle Classes; Will Not Be Delayed For Trainer Conflicts.** A ring will not be held more than 5 minutes for a conflict between 2 over-fences classes. Gatekeepers are authorized to drop late riders to the end of the jumping order or to scratch riders who do not enter a ring in a timely manner, with no refund to exhibitors. Please plan classes accordingly and notify the gatekeepers of legitimate ring conflicts between over-fences classes so that a compatible order can be established. It is recommended that trainers have an assistant available to if a conflict is anticipated.
- **Add/scratch** must be received in the office prior to the start of the class.
- **Proof of a current negative Coggins** test is required to bring horses onto the horse show grounds.
- **Any verbal or physical act of discourtesy** toward a Judge, Show Official, staff or crew member, or Auburn Horse Park employee on the part of a trainer, owner, rider, groom, family member, or person associated with an entry will immediately disqualify that entry, and all fees will be forfeited.
- **Schooling is only permitted in the show rings; at specified times. There will be no schooling over fences on show days without permission.** Riders must wear correct back numbers to enter the show rings at any time. Warm-up rings are available; horses may not be turned loose in the rings.
- **Lunging** will be restricted to designated areas. There will be no lunging in show rings or schooling rings.
- **Measurement cards;** must be shown at check-in.
- **Correct back numbers;** must be worn in all classes or the horse/rider may not receive a score; numbers must be worn to enter any ring for warm-up.
- **Points; cannot be counted** for classes completed by fewer than three horses. Related divisions may be combined when entries in one are fewer than six.
- **Poling and offsets;** are absolutely forbidden anywhere on the show grounds.
- **Dogs; must be on a leash** at all times. Disruptive dogs may be subject to impoundment and/or a \$50.00 penalty added to the owner's show bill.
- **Hunter courses;** will simulate obstacles found in the hunt field such as natural rails, gates, walls, etc.
- **Champion and Reserve ribbons;** will be awarded in each hunter division, as well as ribbons for 1st through 6th place in each class. Age group Equitation classes will be pinned to 6th place; no champion/reserve ribbons or points will be awarded.
- **The class schedule** may be changed for the betterment of the show; Exhibitors agree to show under a substitute judge, should a legitimate need arise.
- **Cheryl & Co,** their employees and officials shall not be responsible for any accident or injury which might occur to persons, horses or to any property while attending the shows, nor will they be responsible for any personal article which may be lost, stolen or destroyed.

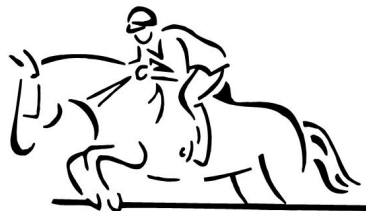

Short Stirrup Equitation Open to qualified Short Stirrup riders. 2'.

11 & Under Equitation Open to juniors, age 11 & under on horses or ponies. 2'.

Long Stirrup Equitation Open to qualified Long Stirrup riders. 2'3".

12-14 Equitation Open to juniors, age 12-14 on horses/ponies. 2'6".

15-17 Equitation Open to juniors, age 15-17 on horses. 3'.

Adult Amateur Equitation Open to amateurs, 18 or over on horses. 3'.

GENERAL INFORMATION

GHJA Classes & Divisions

GENERAL INFORMATION cont.

GHJA Adult Medal Open to amateurs, eighteen or over, on horses, who are current GHJA members. Will be shown at 3' over a modified-jumper type course of at least eight fences. There will be at least one oxer, and one change of direction. A minimum of six riders, if available, will be called back for a flat phase which counts as 25%. The judge may ask riders to perform USEF tests 1-19. The same horse must be ridden in both phases. Three horses must complete both phases in order for points to count.

JD Pounds Medal Open to juniors on horses, who are current GHJA members. Will be shown at 3' over a modified-jumper type course of at least eight fences. There will be at least one oxer, and one change of direction. A minimum of six riders, if available, will be called back for a flat phase which counts as 25%. The judge may ask riders to perform USEF tests 1-19. The same horse must be ridden in both phases. Three horses must complete both phases in order for points to count.

GHJA Pony Medal Open to juniors on ponies, who are current GHJA members. Will be shown at 2' for small, 2'3" for medium ponies and 2'9" for large ponies. Will be shown over a modified-jumper type course of at least eight fences. There will be at least one oxer, and one change of direction. The test may be included in the course or a minimum of six riders, if available, may be called back for a flat phase which counts as 25%. The judge may ask riders to perform USEF tests 1-19. The same horse must be ridden in both phases. Three horses must complete both phases in order for points to count. Course set on 12'.

Jumper classes will be held as Add Backs with \$10 going to the pot and a payout of 35%, 25%, 20%, 10%, 5%, 5%

Low Schooling Jumper will be shown at 3'.

Child/Adult Jumper will be shown at 3'/3'3".

High Schooling Jumper will be shown at 3'6".

UNRATED CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

Warm-Up Will be a blue/red round.

Hopeful Hunter Open to all riders. Will be shown at 2'.

Walk/Halt Open to riders in their first year of showing.

Walk/Trot Open to riders in their first or second year of showing, who have not jumped over 18 inches.

Beginner Crossrails Open to riders in their first or second year of showing, who have not jumped over 18 inches.

Crossrail Hunter Open to riders in their first or second year of showing, who have not jumped over 18 inches.

Pre Rider Open green riders. Open to riders in their first or second year of showing over fences not greater than 18". Courses will be simple verticals.

Pre Hunter Open to Green Horses. Horses can not have jumped over 2 feet. May be ridden by professionals. Courses will be simple verticals. May be combined with Pre Rider if class does not fill.

Hopeful Jumper to be shown at 2'6".

Jumper Classes held as Add Back with \$10 going to the pot and a payout of 35%, 25%, 20%, 10%, 5%, 5%.

This horse show is a local member show of the Georgia Hunter Jumper Association, Inc. and is operated in accordance with the current rules of GHJA. Every person who participates in the show is responsible for a knowledge of and subject to GHJA rules. The following classes/divisions are GHJA recognized and points won in classes with three or more entries will count towards year-end high score award for those entries who are current members, and have a horse recording number.

Hunter over Fences to be shown over at least eight fences at the required height judged on performance and soundness. Hunter under Saddle to be shown at a walk trot and canter. Light contact with horse's mouth required, martingales not permitted.

Open Hunter Open to all horses and ponies. Open to all juniors, amateurs, and professionals. Will be shown at either 2'6" or 3'. Height is at rider's or trainer's discretion.

Junior-Senior Hunter Open to all horses and ponies. Open to juniors and amateurs. Horse and rider combination can not have shown over fences 3'3" at any Local or Regular member horse show. Will be shown at 2'6"

Children's Hunter Open to juniors on horses. Will be shown at 3'.

Adult Amateur Hunter Open to amateurs, 18 or over on horses. Will be shown at 3'.

Jr/Am Hunter Open to amateurs. Will be shown at 3'3"

Working Hunter Open to Professional and Amateur riders. Will be shown at 3'6"

Short Stirrup Hunter Open to riders ages 12 years and under, on horses or ponies, in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any hunter show during the show calendar year. Note: Participation in once around-twice around or beginner and crossrail classes will not count as part of these two years as long as the jump height does not exceed 18". A rider on a pony may cross-enter only into Schooling Pony (2' only) and age group equitation, not to include any medal classes. A rider on a horse may cross-enter only into Junior/Senior Hunter (2'6" only) and age group equitation, not to include any medal classes. Riders may enter non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2' for ponies and 2'6" for horses. Riders may not enter "under saddle" or "flat" classes that do not fall within these parameters. Fence height 2'.

Long Stirrup Hunter Open to Amateur and Junior riders, 13 years of age and older, on horses or ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any hunter show during the calendar year. Note: participation in once around-twice around or beginner and crossrail classes will not count as part of these two years as long as the jump height does not exceed 18". Adult riders who are re-entering the show ring after an absence cannot have shown over fences higher than 2'6" in the past 5 years. Riders may enter non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2'6". Riders may not enter "under saddle" or "flat" classes that do not fall within these parameters. Fence height 2'3"

Schooling Pony Hunter Open to juniors on ponies with GHJA or USEF measurement cards. May be shown at 2' or 2'6" at rider's or trainer's discretion. Courses set on 12'.

Pony Hunter Open to juniors on ponies with GHJA or USEF measurement cards. Smalls to show at 2', riders must be 12 yrs of age or under. Mediums at 2'3", riders must be 14 yrs of age or under and Larges at 2'9". Courses set on 12'

Every entry at a competition shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that all participants (which include, without limitation, owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, rider, handler and the horse) themselves, their principals, representatives, employees and agents (1) **shall be subject to the GHJA rules and competition rules;** (2) represent that every horse, rider, and handler is eligible as entered; (3) agree to be bound by the Rules of the competition and will accept as final the decision of the Horse Show on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold the competition, their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken; (4) agree that as a condition of entry they authorize the competition management to market, transfer, assign or otherwise make use of any photographs, likenesses, films, broadcasts, cablecasts, audiotapes taken of the horse(s) and Participant(s) while on the grounds, incident to or in transit between the stabling facility and the event site, in any way they see fit for the promotion coverage of benefit of the event, without compensation to any of them, so long as the use neither jeopardizes amateur status nor endorses a specific product or service, and hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation; and (5) agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk of serious injury or death, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risk of death, and by participating expressly assume any and all risk of injury or loss, and they agree in indemnity and hold the competition and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless from and against all claims including for any injury or loss suffered during the or in connection with competition, whether or not such claim, injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or competition.
