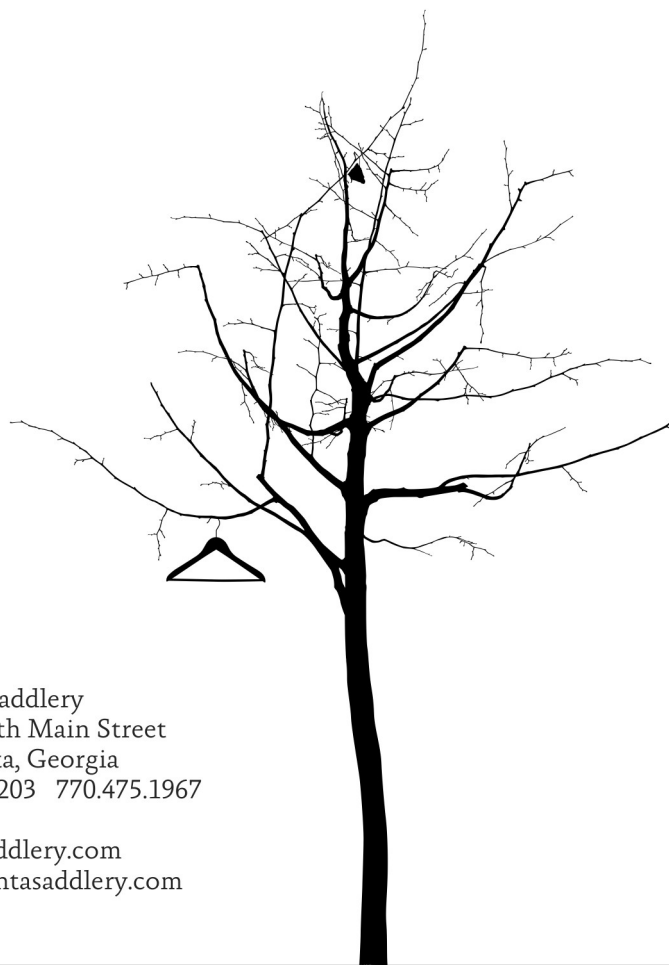

General Information

- **Proper attire** is required in all classes.
- **PROTECTIVE A.S.T.M / S.E.I. APPROVED HEADGEAR IS MANDATORY AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED. Chin straps must be snug.**
- **Classes will be judged** on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.
- **Horses and ponies** may enter no more than seven classes over fences per day, including equitation and all special classes including classic classes.
- **Questions not covered by GHJA rules** will be decided by the horse show management; such decision shall be final.
- **Minor exhibitors** - Parents or guardians shall hold the management, staff, and facility of the horse show harmless for any injury to such minor. A minor's entry will only be accepted when it is signed by a parent or guardian.
- **Golf Carts & Motorized Vehicles** may not be driven by *Unlicensed Drivers* anywhere on the show grounds; violators are subject to suspension from the show . **USEF GR 1301.7**
- **The courtesy circle** may be restricted by a mandatory dotted line which will be indicated on the course diagram.
- **Proof of a current negative Coggins** test is required to bring horses onto the horse show grounds.
- **Any verbal or physical act of discourtesy** toward a Judge, Show Official, staff or crew member, or Will's Park employee on the part of a trainer, owner, rider, groom, family member, or person associated with an entry will immediately disqualify that entry, and all fees will be forfeited.
- **Related GHJA hunter and equitation may be combined** when there are fewer than six entries.
- **Correct back numbers** must be worn in all classes or the horse/rider may not receive a score; numbers must be worn to enter any ring for warm-up.
- **Points cannot be counted** for classes completed by fewer than three entries.
- **Poling and offsets** are absolutely forbidden anywhere on the show grounds.
- **Dogs must be on a leash** at all times. Disruptive dogs may be subject to impoundment and/or a \$50.00 penalty added to the owner's show bill.
- **Hunter courses** will simulate obstacles found in the hunt field such as natural rails, gates, walls, etc.
- **Champion and Reserve ribbons** will be awarded in each hunter division, as well as ribbons for 1st through 6th place in each class. Age group Equitation classes will be pinned to 6th place.
- **The class schedule** may be changed for the betterment of the show; Exhibitors agree to show under a substitute judge, should a legitimate need arise.
- **All ponies showing in Pony Hunter and Equitation classes** must possess a current GHJA measurement card.
- **A 3minute rule** can be imposed at show management's discretion.
- **Brownwood Farm** and it's employees and officials shall not be responsible for any accident or injury which might occur to persons horses or to any property while attending the shows, nor will they be responsible for any personal property which may be lost, stolen or destroyed.

Take I-75/I-85 North. Follow I-85 North to GA 400 North (Cumming). GA 400 North to exit 10 Old Milton Pkwy. Turn left off of exit onto Old Milton Parkway, proceeding North. At the intersection of Highway 9 and Old Milton Parkway, turn left onto Highway 9. Take to Wills Rd. intersection, turn right onto Wills Rd. Wills Park Equestrian Center is on the right.

Horse Show Fees

Stalls: \$65 Weekend/ \$35 per night

Grounds Fee: \$30 per day

All horses on the grounds during the show (Friday-Sunday) that do not have a stall must pay a mandatory grounds fee.

Non-Showing Horse: \$30 per day

Any horse brought on the show grounds (Friday-Sunday) that is not entered in the horse show must pay a mandatory non-showing horse fee.

Office/Medic Fee: \$15.00 per Horse Show Day

Class Fee: \$15

Division Fee: \$40

Beginner Ring Walk/Trot Class Fee: \$12

Ticketed Schooling Friday: \$15

Every horse schooling just on Friday must have a signed entry blank and pay both the grounds and the schooling fee.

Camper Hookup Fee: \$30.00 per day

Late Fee: \$15.00 per Entry

Completed Entry Blanks must be received by Wednesday prior to each show.

There will be no stall reservations without entry blanks.

All shavings must be pre-ordered on entry form.

Note: *Bedding is mandatory each stall must be bedded with at least 2 bags.*

Please note all shavings on your entry form.

Shavings will be billed to your horse show bill at \$7.50 per/bag.

****IMPORTANT****

In accordance with GHJA policies and procedures, a signed entry blank with GHJA membership numbers for each horse, owner & rider must be submitted to the Show Secretary in order for points won to count towards Year-end awards.

GHJA Divisions

Short Stirrup Hunter Fences: 2'. Open to riders ages 12 years and under, on horses or ponies, in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any hunter show. *Participation in once around/twice around or beginner and cross rail classes will not count as part of these two years as long as the jump height does not exceed 18"*. A rider on a pony may cross enter only into either Schooling Pony (2' only) and age group equitation, not to include medal classes. A rider on a horse may cross enter into Jr/Sr Hunter and age group equitation, not to include medal classes. Riders may enter any non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2' for ponies and 2'6" for horses. Riders may not enter under saddle classes or flat classes that do not fall with in these parameters.

Schooling Pony Hunter Fences: 2' or 2'6". May jump either height at the rider's or trainer's discretion. Open to Junior riders only.

Small Pony Hunter 2'. Ponies not to exceed 12.2 hh. Riders must be 12 or under.

Medium Pony Hunter 2'3". Ponies not to exceed 13.2 hh. Riders must be 14 or under.

Large Pony Hunter 2'9". Ponies not to exceed 14.2 hh

Long Stirrup Hunter Fences: 2'3". Open to Amateur and Junior riders, 13 years and older, on horses or ponies. Participation in once around/twice around or beginner and crossrail classes will not count as part of these two years as long as the jump height does not exceed 18". Adult riders who are re-entering the show ring after an absence cannot have shown over fences higher than 2'6" in the past 5 years. Riders may enter non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2'6". Riders may not enter under saddle or flat classes that do not fall within these parameters.

Junior/Senior Hunter Fences: 2'6". Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies; horse/rider combination can have never shown over fences 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show.

Open Hunter Fences: 2'6" or 3'(horse or pony). Rider may show in either height group at rider's or trainer's discretion. May be ridden by an amateur or a professional.

Children's Hunter Fences: 3' Open to all horses ridden by a Junior.

Adult Amateur Hunter Fences: 3' Open to all ponies or horses ridden by an Adult Amateur. Ponies may not cross into any other classes.

Junior/Amateur Hunter Fences: 3'3"

Green Working Hunter: Fences:3' 1st year; Fences 3'3" 2nd year.

Regular Working Hunter Fences: 3'6"

11 and under Equitation Fences 2'

12-14 Equitation Fences 2'6"

15-17 Equitation Fences 3'

Adult Amateur Equitation Fences 3'

Short Stirrup Equitation Fences 2' For riders eligible for Short Stirrup Hunter.

Long Stirrup Equitation Fences 2'3" For riders eligible for Long Stirrup Hunter.
